I-49 LAFAYETTE CONNECTOR Potential Design Modifications Based on Input

- 1. Provide a wider separation between mainline elevated structures
- 2. Realignment of Evangeline Thruway and 2nd/3rd Street Intersection
- 3. Realignment to achieve Castille/MLK Connection
- 4. Evaluate Northbound Braided Ramps in Selected Alternative within Downtown Area
- 5. Evaluate Southbound Braided Ramps in Selected Alternative within Downtown Area
- 6. Resolution of impacts to a new school along Kaliste Saloom Road
- 7. Resolution of hotel property impacts on Hugh Wallis Road
- 8. Resolution of auto dealership impacts south of University Avenue
- 9. Elevate or eliminate frontage roads at Beaver Park, for east/west bicycle/pedestrian connectivity in park and along this portion of Vermilion River
- 10. Minimize airport impacts by evaluating potentially depressing University Avenue/Surrey Street under I-49, or vice versa
- 11. Provide North Gateway area bicycle/pedestrian crossings across corridor
- 12. Provide bicycle/pedestrian pathways full length of I-49 Connector corridor
- 13. Convert one local street across corridor between Downtown and adjacent neighborhoods into bicycle/transit/pedestrian-only corridor
- 14. Evaluate location of Signature Bridge(s)
- 15. Elevate I-49 Connector on structure between Jefferson and Johnston Streets, allowing enhanced local connectivity to/from neighborhoods and downtown
- 16. Raise mainline structure in Downtown area higher than 22-feet to create "gateway" to Downtown without visually impacting adjacent neighborhoods
- 17. Provide railroad underpass at Pinhook Road
- 18. Resolution of potential impacts to historic properties, such as Sterling Grove Historic District and Freetown-Port Rico Historic District (Listed, Eligible, Potentially Eligible)
- 19. Optimize circulation access to/from St. Genevieve Catholic Church along Evangeline Thruway (or other options)
- 20. Improve capacity at I-10/I-49 systems interchange ramps
- 21. Minimize/remediate impact on Live Oak Tree in North Gateway area of corridor
- 22. Straighten the Northbound Thruway near Sterling Grove Historic District to move traffic farther from the neighborhood
- 23. Consideration of ideas presented in the Evangeline Thruway Redevelopment Team (ETRT)
